In **2009**, their gigs included Rhythmix Cultural Works (Alameda CA, audience 200 sitting); Caffe Trieste (Berkeley CA, audience 90 sitting and standing); Fabulosa Fest 2008 and 2009 (Guerneville CA, audience 200 dancing and sitting on the grass); Humanist Hall (Oakland CA, audience 150 dancing); Lake Merritt/Lakeside Park Boat House (Oakland CA, audience 100 eating or dancing); Montclair Women's Cultural Arts Club (Montclair CA, audience over 200 sitting or and dancing); private parties (Oakland CA and Whittier CA, audience usually 75 to 400); airplay on WGOE Internet Radio (Richmond VA); and a 1-hr interview with live performance on a local TV show ("The Inappropriate Show" on Cable TV, Channel 28, BETV in San Francisco and Berkeley, CA--aired all week on three separate weeks in 2009).

In **2010**, their gigs included Sistahs Steppin' in Pride 9th annual East Bay Dyke March & Festival (Oakland CA, audience 1000); Oakland Pride, the largest LGBTQ Pride Festival in East Bay (Oakland CA, audience well over 200 at the Uptown stage); Mama's Vietnamese Restaurant (Oakland CA, audience 80 dancing or eating); and Sun Bell's radio show "Outbeat Music: The Sunnyside" on KRCB Public Radio (www.krcb.org and 91 FM, a 1-hr interview regarding our CD "The Color Of Water"); High Street Station café and restaurant (Alameda CA, audience 100 dancing and sitting); and another couple of weeks of their 1-hr interview with live performance on a local TV show ("The Inappropriate Show" on Cable TV, Channel 28, BETV in San Francisco and Berkeley, CA--aired all week on three separate weeks in 2010).

In **2011**, their gigs included The Oakland Museum Of California (Oakland CA, audience 200); another TV show ("Stephanie's Playhouse Presents" on Cable TV, Channel 28, BETV in San Francisco and Berkeley, CA—aired many times in 2011); and Fabulosa Fest 2011.

In **2012**, their gigs included mostly private parties, and they also took time out to finish their 2nd CD and released it in November at Rooster's Roadhouse in Alameda, CA (audience approx. 150).

In **2013**, their gigs include private parties and some dance parties (High Street Station, Alameda, CA; Rooster's Roadhouse, Alameda, CA). Stay tuned for more in 2013. A third CD is in the works for a 2014 release.
